# 2006 Annual Report

## Letter from the President

Dear Friends,

I'd like to take this opportunity to share some of SOLV's 2006 highlights and some of the challenges facing SOLV and our beloved Oregon. At the end of my second year as President of the Board of Directors, I was struck both by the progress we made and by how much remains to be done.

We can take great pride in our accomplishments:

- ▶ We created and supported an estimated 75,000 volunteer opportunities all around Oregon.
- ▶ We surpassed the 1,000-ton mark of debris gathered during 23 years of our beach cleanups, which began in 1984.
- ▶ Our Earth Day program, SOLV IT, enabled volunteers to remove 265 tons of debris and plant over 3,700 trees, shrubs, bulbs and native plants in the greater Portland metropolitan area. Since 1990, more than 3,685 tons of debris, including more than 40,000 illegally dumped tires have been cleaned up through this program. Volunteers have also removed 2,744 tons of green debris (mostly invasive plant species) as well as planted more than 20,000 trees, shrubs and other plants in the 17 years of SOLV IT.
- ▶ Last year over 750 teachers received our service-learning training and were vital in involving 35,000 students in high quality volunteer activities that met real community needs connected directly to their classroom learning.

These are the kinds of achievements studied last year by the University of Michigan, through a grant from the General Motors Foundation. You may recall that in 2005 GM worked with SOLV to understand how it might establish an organization similar to SOLV in Michigan. The culminating report last year delved into SOLV's economic, environmental, and social impact on the state of Oregon. Among the remarkable findings in the study was the leverage ratio that SOLV programs provide in support to public agencies: \$64.08 to \$1.00.

This is a phenomenal result for Oregon. It also points to a challenge SOLV

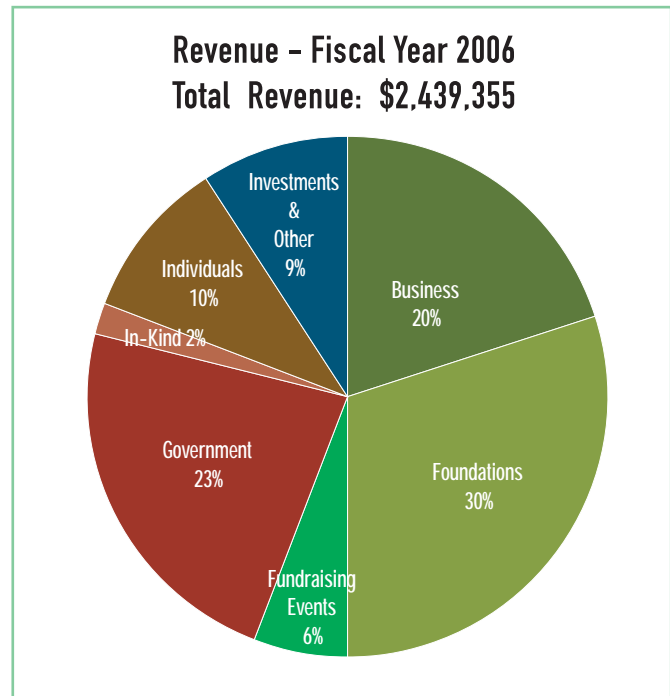

faces: In some ways we have become victims of our own success. Increasing demands for SOLV's services outstripped its available resources last year, causing the organization to dip into its reserve funds and to decrease its planned service in 2007. This can be seen in the current decrease in the number of leadership training sessions being offered around the state, fewer and smaller grants for on-the-ground projects, and the loss of some historic icons, such as the beautiful posters promoting the beach cleanups.

The SOLV staff is working hard to replace funding, especially that lost from some of our federal government contracts for watershed restoration activities. The Board is focused on financial stability and a sustainable level of service. I know that this work will pay off and that SOLV will continue to be an organization admired and emulated around the world.

Thank you for your support during my years as President. I invite your continued help as we work together for this treasure called Oregon.
